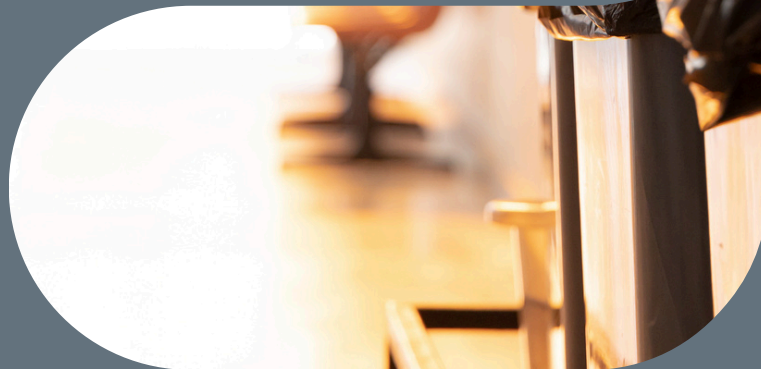

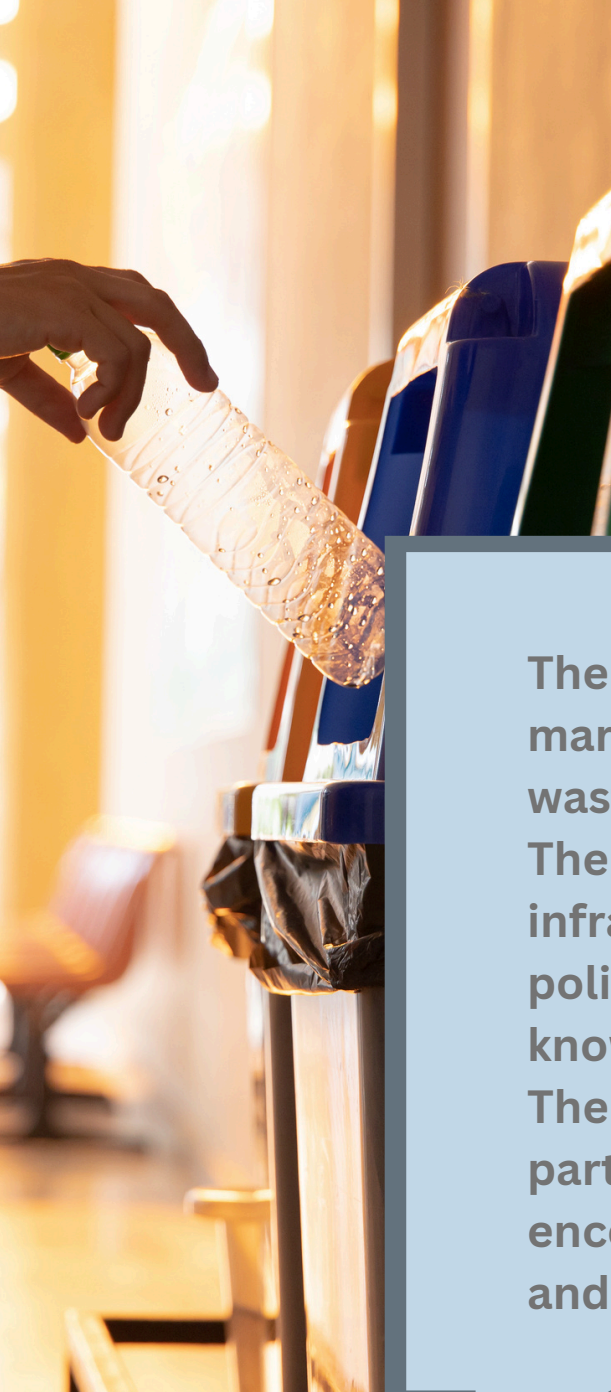

**Transnational Cooperation for Sustainable Waste  
Management and Recycling Practices in the Black Sea Basin**





# Overview

The project aims to decrease pollution, including marine and river litter, by developing sustainable waste management practices in the Black Sea Basin. The partners address challenges such as insufficient infrastructure, lack of public participation, inadequate policy and regulations, and lack of opportunities for knowledge exchange between neighbouring countries. The project aims to establish sustainable cross-border partnerships to reduce landfill waste and pollution by encouraging household waste separation, collection, and recycling.





# Road Ahead

- Joint research and a Guide for Decision Makers to share successful European and local waste management practices for encouraging community to reduce, reuse, recycle (3-R)
- Common 'Waste Management Planning' Training program for policy makers
- Development of a 5-year Zero Waste Regional Strategy for sustainable waste management plans
- Joint International Go2Recycling Movement to engage school children and young people in recycling activities and environmental campaigns
- Zero Waste Neighbourhood Programme focused on waste practices
