The project aims to increase environmental and ocean literacy among young adults in coastal cities to contribute to nature conservation through dissemination trainings, awareness raising videos, an education program, trainers' manuals, and international workshops. The project emphasizes the need for transnational cooperation and harmonization in environmental education, fostering global citizenship and promoting regional collaboration.

- Workshops to design an environmental and ocean literacy programme for young adults and local government representatives
- Joint environmental and ocean literacy education programme for young adults to empower them to make sustainable decisions and take action
- Trainings on environmental and ocean literacy for young adults to promote sustainability led by local civil society organisations and government representatives
- Environmental and ocean literacy dissemination trainings for local government representatives
- Joint social media campaign to highlight environmental sustainability and the impact of human activities on the Black Sea ecosystem
